

Suggestion 3: Offering message

“Brass for Peace” (“BfP”)

Brass for Peace is an organization that works with the Protestant Church of Westfalen and Berliner Missionswerk. Since 2008, “BfP” has been making it possible for children at the Lutheran school “Talitha Kumi” (West Bank/Palestine) to learn to play a brass instrument. The goal is to establish a brass band at the school and especially to strengthen the children’s personalities. All the children have been confronted with the events and consequences of war. Making music has a very positive influence on the children’s social behavior; they have embraced the idea with enthusiasm. Initial encounters with young German brass musicians were made in May 2009 in Germany and more are planned.

The project has now been extended to include the Lutheran school in Beit Sahour and the Lutheran school “Dar al Kalima” in Bethlehem. Brass for Peace depends on donations for the long-term funding of the project.
